Newsbrief

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina urged the United Nations to take special and effective measures to stop the Ukraine-Russia war as soon as possible, saying as fast as the war will be ended it will be better for the people. The Prime Minister made the call during a meeting with UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres at Qatar National Convention Centre (QNCC) yesterday as she arrived in Qatar to attend the 5th United Nations Conference on Least Developed Countries (LDC5: From Potential to Prosperity) on the day.

Executive Chairman of the Tony Blair Institute for Global Change and former British Prime Minister Tony Blair had a breakfast meeting with Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at her official residence Ganabhaban yesterday. During the meeting, the former British Prime Minister apprised the Bangladesh Premier of his institute's activities. Sir Tony Blair also paid homage to Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman in the capital yesterday. He visited Bangabandhu Memorial Museum at Dhanmondi 32 as well.

Road Transport and Bridges Minister Obaidul Quader said BNP has no speed in its movement as like their high voices. The Minister was addressing at the memorial meeting of Moslem Uddin Ahmed, MP, former President of Chattogram South District Awami League (AL) in Chattogram City. Chattogram North and South Districts AL organized the function at city's International Convention Hall yesterday. In the same programme, Information and Broadcasting Minister Dr. Hasan Mahmud said, political workers have a lot to learn from Moslem Uddin Ahmed's political life.

Agriculture Minister Dr. Md Abdur Razzaque said that the next election will be held as per the country's constitution. We will try to bring the BNP in the polls. The Minister said this while speaking at the freshers' reception programme at Kumudini Government College in Tangail yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Minister Dr. Hasan Mahmud said, BNP's existence will face a crisis if it does not participate in the next general election. The Minister urged BNP leaders including Gayeshwar Chandra Roy to keep in mind that hundreds of BNP leaders like advocate Abdus Sattar of Branmanbaria are ready to contest the next parliamentary elections, even if BNP does not join election. The Minister said this in a meeting in Chattogram City organized by Chattogram North and South Districts Awami League yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Anisul Huq said, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has introduced the politics of development by shunning the politics of killing and exploiting performed by BNP and HM Ershad. The Minister said these while speaking at the central council of Bangladesh Deed Writers' Association at the Institute of Engineers, Bangladesh in Dhaka yesterday.

The Chattogram-based factory, NHT Fashions Ltd, a concern of Pacific Jeans Group, has got recognition for establishing green factory thanks to its efforts to continue improving, according to Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA). With the latest one, Bangladesh becomes the home of 66 LEED-certified platinum factories, where most of them are green garment factories.
